Ireland's Department of Education published national AI-in-schools guidance in October 2025, introducing the 4P Framework (Purpose, Planning, Policies, Practice) for ethical, GDPR-compliant implementation; backed by the Data Protection Commission's 2024 guidance on AI and LLMs.
