

IRSID Web Accessibility Inspection under ZDSMA — a Regulator Documenting Its Own Limits (Slovenia)

Summary

Slovenia's accessibility inspectorate carried out 468 inspections in 2022–2024 but states in its own report that understaffing forced it to stop each simplified check after three error types. A rare regulator that publishes the limits of its own monitoring.
