Summary

Iceland's Telecommunications Fund has co-financed fibre-to-the-home broadband for rural farms and remote settlements since 2016, bringing fibre to about 82% of rural households via 57 municipalities by 2024, with a government-funded push to reach 100% coverage by 2026.
