Summary

A joint UN Women–UNDP–UNICEF initiative launched in 2016 to close Bosnia and Herzegovina's gender gap in tech: from a 12-girl pilot coding camp in Sarajevo to the Norway-funded 'Schools of the Future' strand now reaching 500+ students and 70 teachers across 29 schools.
