

Italy's National AI-in-Schools Guidelines — From a 15-School Pilot to Ministerial Decree No. 166

Summary

Italy's education ministry piloted AI assistants in 15 schools across four regions from Sept 2024, tracked via INVALSI tests, trained teachers via 5,760+ PNRR-funded courses, then codified ethics principles in national guidelines (Decree No. 166, Aug 2025).
