In October 2024, Paraguay’s telecom regulator CONATEL and the Ministry of Women hosted an ITU–EY workshop in Asunción teaching young women AI fundamentals, machine learning and AI ethics — one of 13 launch workshops that reached 470+ participants in the program’s first cohort.
