On 16 and 29 October 2024, Malta's digital-government authority MDIA and EY ran ITU-backed AI workshops in Msida and Valletta for women aged 18–25, covering AI, machine learning and ethics as part of a 12-country accelerator that reached 470+ participants in its first cohort.
