

JIC — South Moravian Innovation Centre: From Factory Closures to a Regional Spin-off Pipeline

Summary

Founded in 2003 by Brno, the South Moravian Region and four universities after factory closures, JIC's incubators grew enrolled firms' turnover 9x faster than peers and helped create ~1,400 jobs — though verified figures mostly date to a 2012–14 EU evaluation.
