Summary

A two-year UNFPA/UN Women Joint SDG Fund Programme, concluded November 2024, produced Barbados's first-ever national measurement of unpaid domestic and care work by gender, plus a baseline SDG-indicator study and National Transfer Accounts capacity-building.
