Summary

A Bamako academy pairs a 24/7 AI mentor app in French and Bambara with entrepreneurship training for underemployed youth. A self-commissioned evaluation reports a 71% income rise 18 months after training and \$6.30 per \$1 invested, but names no independent evaluator.
