Summary

Indonesia's reskilling scheme paid out over Rp41 trillion to ~19 million people since 2020. A rigorous lottery-based RCT (AEJ: Economic Policy, 2025) found no detectable impact on employment or consumption, and a 2020 scandal forced two officials to resign.
