Summary

Kazakhstan approved joint ministerial AI-in-education standards (2025–2029) on ethics, data protection and academic integrity for 4.1 million pupils; AI entered school subjects in September 2025, with 3,000+ teachers certified, three-level CPD and a UNICEF partnership.
