Kazakhstan opened 20 Women's Entrepreneurship Development Centres across all regions by 2023, delivering 84,000+ consultations in 2022 alone. Backed by ADB, UNDP, and \$6M in national budget, the network supports a country where women already account for 44.6% of SME owners.
