Summary

Parliament-mandated fund (2020) pays landowners to convert drained farmland to forests/wetlands, financed by certified CO₂ credits. By 2022: 24 forests, 230 ha, 107,500 t CO₂ projected. Green Tripartite Agreement (2024) targets 140,000 ha peatland rewetting by 2045.
