

KOPOP — Slovenia's Agri-Environment-Climate Payments Scheme

Summary

Slovenia's KOPOP scheme pays farmers under its 2023-2027 CAP Plan for water, soil and climate practices — EUR 519.6M budgeted, EUR 39M paid across ~190,000 ha in 2024 — though peer-reviewed studies found earlier versions failed to protect farmland biodiversity.
