

Korea's National Open Data Portal Data-Quality Diagnostic Score

Quality score: 60/100

Evidence strength: Descriptive / self-reported

Summary

Before agencies publish a dataset on Korea's Open Data Portal, a diagnostic service scores it on five criteria — understandability, processing ease, linkability, compliance, importance — inside NIA's quality system, on a portal listing 87,000 datasets and 11,000 open APIs.
