Summary

Founded in 1997 by three Kraków universities, the state and ArcelorMittal, Krakow Technology Park is now a 1,016-hectare zone with 600 investors — but 2025 data show record PLN 21.3bn pledged investment yielding under 3,500 new jobs, the weakest jobs ratio on record.
