

Kukumuty — Miombo Woodland Enrichment Carbon Project (Chibabava, Mozambique)

Summary

Since 2022, Nhaumue and Mangunde communities in Chibabava District have restored native Miombo woodland under Kukumuty, the first project certified under Plan Vivo's tougher 2024 standard, guaranteeing 60%+ of carbon revenue locally; ~74,000 tCO₂e lifetime removals estimated.
