

Kuwait's Interior Ministry Unveils an AI Platform to Speed Up Cybercrime-Report Response

At Kuwait's 7th Cybercrime Conference in January 2026, the Interior Ministry unveiled an AI-assisted platform, built with Interpol cooperation, to analyse citizen cybercrime reports immediately instead of after week-long delays; no outcome data published yet.
