

Latvia's Remigration Coordinator Network

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Quality score: 43/100

Evidence strength: Moderate

Summary

Since 2018, Latvia has run a network of regional remigration coordinators helping citizens abroad move home, assisting 2,456 returnees in 2021-2023 — a modest fraction of the ~420,000-strong diaspora amid decades of severe population loss to emigration.
