

Liberia's First AI Master's Degree — UNDP and Intel Help the University of Liberia Co-Design a National AI Curriculum

UNDP and Intel ran a three-day workshop and six expert-led co-design sessions with 20 University of Liberia faculty to build the country's first Master of AI programme, sealed by a new Intel–UL licensing agreement, under the same March 2025 MoU that also trained Liberian governme
