

LIFE Pyrenees4Clima — Andorra as a Cross-Border Mountain Climate-Resilience Pilot Territory

Summary

The EU LIFE Pyrenees4Clima programme (~€19.8M, 2023-2031, 46 partners) runs Andorra as a pilot site for altitudinal climate monitoring and water-resource modelling, and has published a cross-border wildfire-risk assessment recommending silvopasture recovery.
