Summary

Since 2010, Lima Cómo Vamos has surveyed ~2,000 residents of Metropolitan Lima annually on urban quality of life. A 2022 peer-reviewed study of its 2010–2019 data found satisfaction fell across most dimensions, with steeper declines for lower-income residents.
