

Livox — AI-Adaptive Augmentative Communication App Scaled Across Recife's Public Schools

Summary

Livox, an AI-adaptive augmentative-communication app built by a father for his daughter with cerebral palsy, was formally adopted into Recife's public schools — 500 tablets across 111 schools — after a favourable review from Brazil's federal technology-research institute.
