A four-day Lao-Korean workshop paired Luang Prabang's mostly informal entrepreneur base (2,788 new micro-SMEs in 3 years, only 250 registered locally) with Sejong City, Hannam University and Sejong Techno Park to co-design mentoring, internships and a startup-support centre.
