

Mada Center's National e-Accessibility Programme — Qatar's Government Websites Reach a 92% Accessibility Score

Summary

Qatar's Mada Center paired a 2011 e-Accessibility Policy with government audits and training, raising websites' average accessibility score to 92% across 42 agencies by 2019, and helping Qatar rank 1st of 137 countries on the 2020 UN DARE Index.
