Summary

World Bank-funded (\$72.4 M IDA, 2017–2024) programme that trained 19,000+ youth at 10 Tech Hubs, cut wholesale internet prices 98% (from \$460 to under \$10/Mbit/s), and brought nearly 7 million Malawians online for the first time.
