

Malta Commits EUR 4M to Put Microsoft 365 Copilot on 8,000 Public Officers' Laptops

Malta's government partnered with Microsoft in a EUR 4 million, two-year plan to give 8,000 public service employees Microsoft 365 Copilot, backed by a new Government Copilot Centre of Excellence. Independent outcome metrics are not yet published.
