Summary

Mozambique's flagship Maluana Science & Technology Park, on 950 hectares in Maputo province, grew from 3 resident companies in 2019 to 10 today against a 90-company capacity, after UNCTAD's 2018 technology-park review flagged it as unsustainable for failing to attract tenants.
