

Mexico's Anexo 13 — Two Decades of Ring-Fenced Federal Budget for Women's Equality

Summary

Created in 2008, Latin America's first such mechanism, Mexico's federal budget Annex 13 earmarks spending for women's equality; the total grew from 233.7bn pesos (2022) to 479.2bn pesos (2025), though analysts warn much funds non-transformative programmes.
