Sri Lanka's Ministry of Education signed a March 2024 MoU with Microsoft to pilot AI in the Grade 8+ IT curriculum across 20 schools in 20 districts, training 100 teachers in a train-the-trainer model ahead of a targeted 2025 full rollout.
