Summary

A solar-powered Mobile Learning Lab brings offline, adaptively-sequenced digital lessons (KA Lite / Kolibri platform) to 640 out-of-school adolescent girls across 30 accelerated-learning centres in rural Koinadugu and Falaba, Sierra Leone.
