

# MoorFutures Peatland Carbon Standard (Germany)

## Summary

World's first peatland-rewetting carbon standard, launched 2011 in Mecklenburg-Vorpommern. MoorFutures certificates (EUR 30-123/tCO<sub>2</sub>e) fund bog rewetting across four German states; over 50,000 tCO<sub>2</sub>e retired at Koenigsmoor since 2014; buyers include McDonald's and Commerzbank.
