Imagine Worldwide and onebillion's MsingiTek deploys solar-powered, AI-adaptive literacy/numeracy tablets across five mainland Tanzanian regions and all of Zanzibar, building on five RCTs (effect sizes above 0.3 SD) and a government MOU targeting 500+ schools by 2026.
