MTN South Sudan's 2025 Y'ello Care campaign built solar 4G hubs in Mangateen IDP camp and Gorom refugee settlement near Juba, giving 2,800+ displaced residents free e-learning, e-health and mobile-money training; the wider campaign reached 40,000+ people in four communities.
