Summary

VCS-certified mangrove restoration in the Ayeyarwady Delta: 2,065 ha restored since 2015, targeting 3.6 MtCO₂e over 20 years (~184,000 tCO₂e/yr). WIF with 11,000 beneficiaries in 16 villages. Myanmar's 2021 military coup creates governance uncertainty.
