Mauritius Telecom and the Ministry of Education piloted mytGPT, an AI tutoring assistant, with about 70 Grade 12 students in Rodrigues from Aug-Oct 2025, expanding to 8 primary and secondary schools by January 2026; no learning-outcome data has yet been published.
