Opened October 2023 with a ~US\$41-44m facility funded by public and corporate sponsors, Vietnam's flagship National Innovation Center anchors partnerships with NVIDIA, Google, Samsung, Intel and SpaceX to build AI/R&D; capacity — job-creation data are not yet available.
