Summary

Mauritius's Office of the President and Ministry of Education run an annual AI challenge for Grade 12 students: the 2025 pilot drew 700+ students from 69 schools submitting 94 AI projects; 2026 winners, including a Rodrigues school, earned Mauritius Telecom AI internships.
