

Nenech se — A National Anonymous Digital Contact Channel Linking Domestic-Violence Victims to Czech Intervention Centres

Summary

Since 2021, Nenech.se lets people threatened by domestic violence in Czechia request anonymous, coded online contact with their local Intervention Centre — built by startup Nenech to být (FaceUp) with APIC, since abusers often control victims' phones and email.
