Summary

New Zealand's Ministry of Justice has funded ~48 non-violence programme providers since 2014, handling 6,000+ referrals yearly. A 2018 study found 46-49% fewer reoffences after non-mandated referrals; 2023 reporting found serious outcome-tracking gaps.
