

NextGen Workforce — Upskilling Kosovo's Youth (84% Women) for the AI Era

Summary

Women in Tech Kosovo and Luxembourg's development agency LuxDev ran an AI/digital-skills programme in which 77 young Kosovars (65 women) completed training in AI, programming and cybersecurity, building AI-driven websites before a study visit to Luxembourg.
