

Nigeria's NDPC Compliance Notice — Auditing Data Protection Across 649 Education Institutions

Summary

On 19 Feb 2026 Nigeria's Data Protection Commission gave 649 universities, polytechnics and colleges 21 days to prove compliance with the 2023 Data Protection Act — audit returns, DPO appointments — building on a 2024 notice naming education a 'major importance' sector.
