

Noor Educational Platform — Oman's National Digital-Classroom and AI-Readiness Rollout

Quality score: 60/100

Evidence strength: Descriptive / self-reported

Summary

Oman's Ministry rolled out the Noor digital-classroom platform to 578 schools (96% teacher access) by 2025, expanding to 730 in 2025–26. A separate 243-teacher survey found reported admin-burden cuts of ~20% and 65% of 266 students found AI-enhanced lessons more engaging.
