

Norway's National Tiered Restriction on Generative AI in Primary and Secondary Schools

Summary

Norway's government announced on 19 June 2026 that pupils aged 6-13 will be barred from using generative AI in school from August 2026, with supervised use for ages 14-16, independent use encouraged from age 17, and increased funding for printed books over AI tools.
