

Numé-Raï — New Caledonia's Digital-Skills and Accessibility Programme for Disabled and Rural Residents

Summary

Numé-Raï runs 35 digital-skills workshops across 9 New Caledonian municipalities, targeting 500 participants (half with disabilities), alongside a 2024 scan finding 99% of roughly 2,000 local websites had accessibility errors.
