Founded in Amman in 2010, Oasis500 is one of the MENA region's first early-stage accelerators. By 2026 it had backed 193 startups, generated ~USD 135M in follow-on funding, created ~5,000 jobs, and launched its fourth fund (Oasis Ventures III, USD 20M+).
