Summary

IOC and Tree Aid agroforestry programme across 90 villages in Mali and Senegal targeting 2,120 ha and 200,000 tCO₂ via Plan Vivo certification; 72,505 of the planned ~355,000 trees planted by March 2023, part of Africa's Great Green Wall.
