Summary

Orange's digital skills hub in Ouagadougou delivered 243,000 training hours to 4,869 young Burkinabe in 2025 alone, 1,255 of them women, placing 100+ graduates into jobs and coaching 15 startups, part of a five-year GIZ-co-funded push now expanding to a second site in Koudougou.
