Launched in Port Vila in 2024, the Pacific Girls in ICT Day programme reached 2,000+ girls and 500+ boys across seven Pacific nations; its 2025 edition added an AI-literacy session via 'Smart Islands' digital hubs on remote atolls in Kiribati, the Marshall Islands, Vanuatu, Tonga
